### Essay Requirement:

- Applicant must write a 900 to 1000-word essay on the following prompt:
- Describe an ideal leader who ensures social equality and represents as well as promotes the interests of the Vietnamese community.
  - ▶ *Identify past experiences and personal traits that qualify you as this type of person.*
  - ▶ *Student can describe his/her community service experience or any events in his/her life that he/she feels appropriate for this prompt.*

### Essay guidelines:

- Essay must be double spaced with 1" margins
- Times New Roman 12 font
- Applicant first name and last name must be at bottom of each page along with page number - Total word count

### Submission:
